This survey is an ongoing effort of the 60 Plus Association. The responses are from one of the most recent polls.

Question 1: Are you happy with the health care you are currently receiving through Medicare?

- Yes, very much: 60%
- Somewhat: 30%
- No: 10%

Question 2: Are you aware that Medicare is already at risk and expected to go bankrupt by 2029?

- Yes: 70%
- No: 30%

Question 3: Does your Medigap insurance plan fill the void with regards to medical procedures not covered by Medicare?

- Yes, very much: 60%
- Somewhat: 30%
- No: 10%

Question 4: The most recent dramatic change to our healthcare system was the Affordable Care Act (Obamacare). How did the implementation of this government-mandated program affect you personally? (Please check all that apply)
